

- Do not use the Vacuum Cleaner to vacuum toys, paper balls and other large objects, otherwise it will cause blockage of the Vacuum Cleaner, motor burnout and other failures.
- Keep the Vacuum Cleaner away from fire and other hot places.
- Make sure to install the filter modules and the roller brush of the floor brush.
- Make sure not to block the suction inlet or block the roller brush, as this may cause motor failure when using the Vacuum Cleaner.
- Do not pour or spill water or other liquids into the machine to avoid short circuits and burning out the machine.
- Fully charge the battery when using a new battery or the battery used for the first time after long-term storage. Please ensure that it is charged and discharged at least every three months when the machine is not used for a long time.

- The appliance is only to be used with the power supply unit provided with the appliance.
- The plug must be removed from the socket-outlet before cleaning or maintaining the appliance.
- Please do not use or store the Vacuum Cleaner in high temperatures, low temperatures and other adverse conditions, and do not use them outdoors or on wet surfaces. It is recommended to use them indoors at an ambient temperature of 0-30°C. Please store it in a cool and dry place, and do not expose it to sunlight for a long time.
- Do not allow children to use or play with the Vacuum Cleaner.
- When the Vacuum Cleaner can not work, it must be tested and repaired at the designated service center. Do not disassemble the machine by yourself. Waste battery packs should be safely recycled and disposed of, please do not dispose of them at will.
- If the power cord is damaged, in order to avoid danger, you must go to the manufacturer's local maintenance department or similar department to have it replaced by a professional.










2-in-1 dusting brush

Product Assembly


1. Battery installation and removal


Installation: align the battery with the back-end position of the vacuum unit and slide it in until it is clamped in place.


2. Installation and disassembly of the whole machine

Installation: insert the electric floor brush joint at the dust pipe, and the other end of the dust pipe at the vacuum unit when the installation is complete.

Removal: Press the corresponding release button and pull it out to remove the electric floor brush and the host.







Removal: press the battery release button and pull it out for removal.

Operation

In the process of use, when the display light flashes, it indicates that the power is insufficient, and it needs to be recharged in time so as not to affect the use.


Note: please charge with the original power adapter.

Charging:

1. As shown in the picture, the charging plug on the power adapter is inserted into the charging port of the battery and it will be charged. When the charge is displayed as three lights constantly lit indicates full charge.




2. As shown in the picture, after the battery is removed, insert the charging plug into the charging port on the battery, the indicator light is flashing blue, indicating that it is charging; the indicator light is solid, indicating full charge.




1. Press the switch button and the machine starts working; press the switch button again and the machine shuts down.

2. The machine has two suction gears, short press " 🕺 ", different suction gears can be switched.



Display screen indications




Maintenance

Cleaning of dustbin


1. Aim the bottom of the dustbin at the garbage can, press the dustbin cover release button, open the dustbin cover automatically, and gently shake it to empty the dust in the dustbin.

Note: Please clean the dustbin after each use to ensure the best cleaning effect.



Cleaning of filter components

Press the dust cup release button, and then turn it clockwise as shown in the figure till it cannot move, and then take out the dust cup downward.






Cleaning of filter components

Note: after rinsing inlet and outlet filters with water, please air dry them before use (do not expose them in the sun).

Note: to maintain the best cleaning performance, it is recommended to clean them once a week.



Warning:

- 1.Do not use this machine when filter components are not installed!
- 2. Filter components are prohibited from being used before they are dried completely after flushing.




Cleaning of electric floor brush

1. As shown in the picture, push the lock button down to the unlocked state, and take out one end of the roller brush and pull out the whole brush.


Note: when pulled out, some dust will fall.

2. Remove any hair or debris on the roller brush. If it is washed with water, it must be fully dry before returning to the brush housing.



Maintenance

After use, the vacuum can be hung on the wall using the wall mount for convenient storage.



Troubleshooting

Fault	Possible Issues	Solution
The machine cannot be started.	The battery is not installed correctly	Install the battery correctly
	The battery is dead	Charge the battery
Vacuum cleaner has no suction/- suction becomes smaller.	The dustbin is full	Empty the rubbish in the dustbin
	The suction of the dust pipe or floor brush is blocked by a foreign body	Clean up the suction of the dust pipe or floor brush
	Dustbin or filters are not installed correctly	Reinstall the dustbin and filters
	Filter blockage	Clean filters, dry fully and put it back
Dust is leaking from the air outlet.	Filters are not installed correctly	Install filters correctly
